Our IVF costs are split across three clear stages, and include medication.

Medication included

Cycle preparation stage: Your doctor will select the best medication dosage to suit your needs.

Stages 1+2

All medication to get you through to and including egg collection is included at Stage 1.

Please note: it's possible that you may require additional medication – your medical team will let you know if this applies to you.

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Non-IVF treatment

Non IVF treatment costs involve both a set “cost per cycle” plus the variable cost of medication.

Invoice timing and payment

- IUI is invoiced on Day 1 of treatment and the account is to be paid prior to insemination;
- Monitored ovulation induction is invoiced on Day 1 of treatment and the account is to be paid prior to scanning;
- Fertility Boost will be invoiced and must be paid in full prior to the issuance of the prescription.

About payment

Consultation

To be paid on the day of appointment.

Pre-treatment and storage

To be paid within 14 days of invoice.

IVF treatment

You will be invoiced at each of the three stages.

Stage 1 Medication and monitoring

Stage 2 Egg collection and embryology

Stage 3 Embryo transfer

For your convenience we have a number of ways in which you can pay for your IVF treatment.

Staged payments

Stage 1 Medication and monitoring is invoiced when your individualised treatment plan is confirmed and must be paid before medication can be issued.

Stage 2 Egg collection and embryology is due to be paid before egg collection.

Stage 3 Embryo transfer is invoiced on the day of transfer and payment is required on the same day.

Pre-payment: pay up-front

You can pay up-front for Stages 1, 2 and 3 as per your estimate. We will refund any overpayment or invoice additional costs at the end of your cycle.

Fertility Cover

Pay a single up-front fee covering up to three cycles of IVF over an 18 month period. If treatment does not result in a live birth after the three cycles, you will receive a 70% refund (terms and conditions apply). Please contact your clinic for further information regarding this option or visit www.fertilitycover.co.nz before starting treatment.
