

Fees For Ethics Applications

Valid until 31 March 2018

Approval from the Ethics Committee on Assisted Reproductive Technology (ECART) is required prior to treatment involving:

- Surrogacy;
- Donor egg PLUS donor sperm;
- Donor embryos;
- Donations between certain family members.



Ethics Committee Application Fee

- All applications to the Ethics Committee incur an application fee.
- The Ethics Application fee is charged at the first counselling consultation.
- Please contact your local Fertility Associates Counsellor if you have any questions regarding your unique situation.

ECART Application Fee - \$2,700



Important To Know

- Obtaining approval from Ethics Committee typically takes a minimum of 4-6 months and involves multiple counselling, medical consultations and reports required for ECART. These are all included in the ECART application fee.
- Eligibility for publicly funded treatment does not cover the costs of the ECART application.



Legal Advice

Treatment involving surrogacy and donor embryos requires each party to obtain independent legal advice. If you do not have a lawyer, Fertility Associates can recommend a lawyer who specialises in this field.
