

Donor Treatment fees

Valid until 31 March 2019

Donor fees are in addition to treatment cycle fees. Please refer to the Treatment Fees guide to understand the costs of a donor treatment cycle.

Counselling

All donors, surrogates and intending parent(s), attend at least one counselling consultation. The first counselling consultation for donors and surrogates is included in the donor costs outlined below. Additional counselling consultations are paid by the intending parent(s).

Counselling consultation	\$165 per consultation
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NOTE: ECART Applications are required when using both Donor Egg and Donor Sperm together; a donor who is a close family member; Donor Embryo; or Surrogacy. Please refer to our "Fees for Ethics Applications" guide and talk to a Fertility Counsellor.

Donor Treatment Costs

Since 2017 all Fertility Associates donors are screened for three commonly inherited genetic conditions; Cystic Fibrosis, Fragile X Syndrome and Spinal Muscular Atrophy. Donors are also screened for infectious diseases. Our donor fees include these screening tests, medical consultation(s) for donors, counselling for donors and costs incurred to recruit clinic donors.

Screening tests for sperm quality. Includes semen analysis, SCSA for DNA fragmentation, strict sperm morphology and trial wash	\$505
Donor preparation. Includes medical and counselling consultations for the donor, Genetic Carrier Screening and storage of up to 3 samples. Additional samples will be charged the standard fee for semen analysis + sperm freezing + 6 months storage.	\$1,950

ABOUT EGG DONOR FEES & PAYMENT

- * Donors have two medical consultations, one prior to treatment and another following treatment.
- ** Subsequent cycle fee applies to additional cycles occurring within 6 months of the first cycle, using the same donor as the 1st cycle and no further doctor consultations or counselling is required.
- *** Guaranteed embryo transfer fee is an optional service available to intending parent(s) using an egg donor. If there are no embryos suitable to transfer, the intending parent(s) receive a refund of \$10,000. Eligibility criteria applies - please see over page for more information.

1st cycle with surrogate including screening, medical consultations* and counselling of surrogate	\$2,385
Subsequent cycle with the same surrogate, additional to IVF treatment	\$515
Screening and preparation of additional potential surrogates, charged per surrogate screened	\$1,000

TREATMENT USING DONOR SPERM

SPERM DONOR RECIPIENTS

- Recipients using a personal sperm donor pay the screening fee at the time they book a semen analysis with the lab. The preparation fee is payable at the donor's medical consultation.

TREATMENT USING DONOR EGGS

EGG DONOR RECIPIENTS

- Recipients of donor eggs pay for treatment when or before their donor collects medication, which is prior to treatment starting
- Recipients using a personal egg donor pay the egg donor fee when we begin screening and preparation of an egg donor
- Recipients pay the donor reimbursement when the donor starts her treatment cycle
- The clinic passes on the full reimbursement to the donor at the time of egg collection
- Donor reimbursement applies irrespective of the outcome of the donor's cycle

ABOUT DONOR REIMBURSEMENT

- The standard reimbursement covers typical expenses such as parking, child care, time and inconvenience
- If the donor lives out of town and requires air fares and accommodation, these will require extra reimbursement
- The reimbursement applies to all recipients, whether using a clinic or personal donor, and whether treatment is privately or publicly funded
- Personal donors may elect to forgo reimbursement – this would need to be agreed in advance on a 'case by case' basis between the clinic and the donor

ADDITIONAL TO THE EGG DONOR TREATMENT COSTS

- There may be additional treatment fees, for instance if the donor needs an anaesthetist for heavier sedation

GUARANTEED EMBRYO TRANSFER

- This optional service is available to eligible recipients of egg donation. For \$770 Fertility Associates' guarantees that your egg donation cycle will produce at least one embryo suitable for transfer. And if not, you will receive a refund of \$10,000.
